**DAVIES CREEK NATIONAL PARK**

20km DAY LOOPS

8 WITH FACILITIES

60km DAY LOOPS

- Bunda Bibandji Aboriginal Rock Art Galleries** Take a step back in time and walk with the spirits of the ancestors. Guided tours only.
- Davies Creek Falls** is a spectacular waterfall cascading through ancient granite rock formations. Recommended at sunset.
- Kahlpahim Rock** (Lambs Head), at 1300m above sea level this is the highest point on the Lamb Range in the Davies Creek National Park.

**BARRON GORGE NATIONAL PARK**

27km DAY LOOPS

3 WITH FACILITIES

- Clohesy River Fig Tree Walk** is an easy short 300 metre boardwalk through a small and picturesque patch of mature rainforest.
- The Kauris** are giant cathedral old-growth *Agathis robusta*, likely hundreds of years old, and mark the place of Toby's Bama campsite. The dendrogllyph can still be seen on closer inspection.
- Toby's Lookout** gives a spectacular view to the coast, at 1000m above sea level, from Yorkeys Knob to Barron River mouth on the Coral Sea.

**FORMARTINE FOREST**

8km IN & OUT

- Secret Mountain** on the old maps, traverse across saddles of drier country climbing to the summit at 300m to cool down in the remnant Kauri rainforest.

**BARRON GORGE NATIONAL PARK**

4km SHORT LOOPS

- Kuranda Art Trail
- Jumrum Creek Walk - Jungle Walk - River Walk
- Rainforest Canopy Walk & Barron Falls Lookout

- Barron Falls** is a spectacular waterfall cascading 125m to continue it's journey to the coast.
- Wright's Lookout** elevation 381m offers dramatic, sweeping views of the coastal lowlands.
